Guidance for using the Play Equipment

- The play equipment has been installed on an all weather surface and so the children should always have access to it at all playtimes and lunchtimes.
- Staff should check the equipment visually at the start of each playtime for any unforeseen risk before the children use it.
- One member of staff should be supervising the equipment and ensuring the children are using it safely eg. No bouncing, showing awareness of others, wearing suitable footwear etc.
- Children should be asked to access the equipment from the main path and stay on the all weather surface when the grass is wet. The staff member supervising the equipment should ensure this is followed.
- Children should be reminded by staff to take greater care in wetter conditions as they would in a park.
- If a child gets stuck up the space net, a staff member or older child should talk them down, not lift them off.
- Any child not following the rules should receive an explanation, be given a verbal warning and asked to leave if the behaviour persists.
- Teaching staff should supervise the equipment before school, parents have responsibility after school.
